Bible readings

We read from the New International Version (NIV). Bibles are available at the door. The page number for the church bibles will be announced to help you find the reading.



On-screen information

Before and after the service information on our various activities is displayed on the main screen. During the sermon there will usually be some notes on the screen to help you follow what's being said.



Singing

We use Praise! hymn books and also use the main screen to project some songs. The song numbers are displayed in the front right-hand corner. Morning worship is accompanied by our music group.



Kidzone (morning service)

We have a short time as part of the morning service aimed primarily at primary age children.



Children of pre-school age (morning service)

We have a creche room with a large window view into the church hall. A church member will always be on hand during the sermon to look after your child. Prior to the sermon we would respectfully ask that you remain with your child if they are using the creche room, thank you. You can listen to the sermon via a speaker (with volume control).

NB: During the evening service the creche room is still open for your use but there will not be a church member on duty.



Toy Bags: are available on your right as you enter the main hall. Please feel free to use them.



Children of primary school age (morning service)

We offer two Sunday Club classes to cover this age range. This runs during the sermon.

Children of secondary school age (morning service)

To help young people to follow the sermon, worksheets with questions are produced every week. If you would like one, please ask one of the stewards on the door. We provide pencils and clipboards too!



Welcome time ... we invite you to stay on after the service to enjoy a cup of tea or coffee and to get to know us.



Offering

There is no money offering taken during the service. No money is ever asked for or expected. Should you feel you want to donate to the work of the church, there is an offering box at the back of the hall.
